Eternity is in my heart. It lies there, well protected. My heart would be so empty if it wasn't there. It is unimaginably big. Unimaginably long. Unimaginably beautiful. It's an unimaginable concept! Infinite breadth, infinite time, infinite beauty. I can grasp what I can imagine and make it huge and think I've got at least a vague idea of something I can't understand. It's astonishing that something so big has a place in my heart. To contemplate one's own finiteness, that's a special ability of us human beings. It brings us in contact with God. God has placed eternity in our hearts. I try to picture the beginning and end of something that has no beginning and no end: Creation and eternal life. "There is a time for everything... to be born and to die, to plant and to uproot." (3:1-2) Even longing and understanding have their time. Eternity is one long road. We are travelling along it. The Lord Jesus shows us the way of salvation: This IS the way! HE is the beginning and the end. HE knows the final destination!

Taking stock...

At the end of June we stepped down from the leadership of the **BEG's Foreign Missions Department (TAM)** and we can look back in deep gratitude on twenty years' involvement in this exciting area of ministry. Many contacts have been made and new initiatives put in place including **partnerships with more than twenty-five different missionary societies**, and, in particular, opportunities for motivated Austrians to go out to just about every country in the world. At the end we took stock and worked out the number of those who contacted TAM with a view to taking part in missionary work. We were amazed ourselves and **we give God the glory**: There were well over **two hundred people** that we have been able to support short- or long-term. At the time that we stepped down we had been taking care of **about ninety short-term and over thirty-five long-term missionaries** who had found their place in world mission. Behind every co-worker who has been sent out there are committed churches who are supporting that person's ministry and carrying them in prayer! Without this 'covering', world mission would not be possible!

We are **filled with deep gratitude** when we think of you and your valuable support over all these years!

The next step... - South Africa??

Recently we **booked our flight to Johannesburg and Cape Town (9th-30th Oct.)!** How did this come about? A decisive factor in our consideration of this direction was the newsletter from a Swiss colleague working with SIM in which she described her work and the challenges of **Member Care**. She mentioned that she and her team were often overwhelmed and urgently needed more people to help. **We were really moved by this and it has stayed with us!** Following on from this we got in touch with the leaders. Then we had an invitation to get to know the team and the situation on the ground and 'get a taster' of Member Care work. We would also like to find out if we are in a position to live and work in the strict security conditions which are normal in South African cities. In the first full discussion with the regional leaders via Skype we found out that **SIM has about 300 international co-workers in South Africa and in 9 of the 14 'ROSA states'** ('Region Of Southern Africa').

SIM: 'Serving In Mission' is the most important missionary society for us after the DMG.

All this is a considerable step of faith for us and we are excited to see where God will lead us!
