She was our neighbour in Leichlingen (in the Rhineland), she had no children and she had just been widowed. She got to know our family and linked up with the local Baptist church. Little Annika got on really well with her. Through a ‘Pro Christ’ outreach event, Gisela came to a [living faith](#) in Jesus! [That was a real joy!](#) From then on, she read the Bible daily and she read it so much that it soon started to fall apart. We brought her a new one, which has now been given to us to keep in memory of her... Even this Bible showed clear signs of regular use. [It is a great comfort](#) to know that we will see her again...!

Also while we were in Leichlingen we got to know some people who have remained our friends... In mid-November, we were invited to the home of Klaus and Gaby in the south of Austria. They are related to our friends. The friends had also travelled specially from north Germany. Klaus had expressed the wish to know more about faith in Jesus. After many serious conversations, the two of them asked us to help them to put their lives in order before God! Following repentance, confessing their sins, making a conscious decision to enter a new life with Jesus and receiving complete forgiveness, a [great joy and a new hope](#) shone from them, affecting all of us! [Unbelievable! Exciting! Infectious!](#) Someone said, “That was cause for a big party in heaven: “The birth of twins”! [Would you pray for them with us?](#) For great spiritual hunger – for connecting with Christians in their area – for healing from the past – for growth in faith and trust in Jesus – and for physical healing for Klaus, his life is hanging by a thread!
