“God is not far from each one of us. For in HIM we live and move and have our being.” Acts 17:27–28 – In the course of Paul’s missionary journey, he arrives in Athens. He carefully observes how the people there live out their religious convictions. Among all the many shrines to the gods, he comes across an altar dedicated ‘TO AN UNKNOWN GOD’. Paul picks up on this and tells people about the living God who is closer to us than we could ever imagine. Paul senses the longing in people’s hearts. What they have known up to now clearly was

enough. It could not satisfy the deep needs of their souls: **“Do not continue to seek the unknown. The living God has come to you in the Lord Jesus Christ!”** HE does not sit enthroned somewhere in the vast expanse of the universe, but shares our lives with all their joys and sorrows. **HE is only a prayer away!** No one is too poor, too sick or too insignificant! Before HIM, I can acknowledge and confess the things that have gone wrong in my life up until now and where I have burdened myself with a deep sense of guilt. Then no one and nothing can exclude me from fellowship with this living God. I am interconnected with HIM like the threads in woven cloth. Indivisibly. Always. For ever. ‘Woven’ into the love of God which holds and carries me.
